Notice of Race

1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US SAILING), the rules of the International Lightning Class Association (ILCA) and this Notice Of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 The organizing authority is South Shore Yacht Club for Tuesday evening Lightning Season Series racing.

2 Eligibility, Entry and Insurance

2.1 Eligible boats and their owner(s) shall be and remain members in good standing of the South Shore Yacht Club Lightning Fleet #79. All SSYC Lightning season series participants must belong to one of the following organizations; South Shore Yacht Club, Milwaukee Yacht Club or the Milwaukee Community Sailing Center. Visiting sailors, not affiliated with the previously mentioned organizations are welcome to sail in two (2) Tuesday evening events without club affiliation provided an entry, fee and proof of insurance is provided to the Race Committee one day prior to participating.

2.2 Eligible boats and their owner(s) shall carry the South Shore Yacht Club required minimum of \$300,000 liability insurance and have a certificate of insurance (COI) on file three days prior to the first race to be sailed in order to be considered registered.

3 Fees

3.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and fee of (\$30.00) or (\$0.00 for paid Club Juniors/students) and forwarding Patrick McGuinnis co SSYC 2300 E Nock Street, Milwaukee, WI 53207

3.2 Competitors from outside of the local area clubs (SSYC, MYC, and MCSC) may compete in the Tuesday night series with registration and payment of annual dues and proof of US Sailing membership.

4 Schedule

Racing will be every Tuesday evening, June 6 through August 29, 2017. There will be no racing on June 20, July 4, July 11, and July 18, 2017 due to conflicts with other races and the holiday. 2 races will be sailed each night [conditions permitting].

5 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available at SSYC or from the Fleet Captain Pat McGuinnis or online @ <http://www.ssy.org>.

6 Courses & Racing Area

The racing areas will be Course #1: Inside the harbor, south end near the landfill per the sailing instructions [Illustration "A"] as the default, or Course #2: Outside the South Shore harbor break-wall, 0.5 miles East of the rubble gap. Courses will be windward leeward [Illustration "B"] per the sailing instructions. The number of laps [W1 or W2] will be posted and hailed before each warning signal.

7 Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4, will be used. One race constitutes a series. See the Sailing Instructions for further details. Two boats racing will constitute a race for the purpose of scoring.

8 Prizes

The South Shore Lightning Fleet Perpetual Champion Trophy will be awarded to the boat with the lowest score and trophies will be presented at the winner's dinner.

9 Social Events

The SSYC Lightning Fleet will gather after racing for a time of fellowship at the SSYC clubhouse.

10 Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta. The organizing

authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to during or after the regatta.
