NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Kaszube Cup Regatta (Regatta) will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Racing rules 61.1 and 63.7 will be changed as follows:
RRS 61.1, Informing the Protestee, will be amended so that a protesting boat shall also notify the race committee of her intent and the protested boat number.
RRS 63.7, Conflicts Between Rules, will be amended so the protest committee will hear and apply the RC's intention of the SI(s) concerned.
The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Club/Collegiate 420, standard and radial rig Laser, and Optimist classes that meet the following requirements:
- a) Club/Collegiate 420, and Laser competitors' and alternates' ages shall be 13 through 19 years during the calendar year, and shall not turn 20 until after the last day of the regatta.
 - b) Optimist competitors shall be 8 through 15 years old during this regatta:
Green Fleet: Class requirements, White Fleet: 8 through 10 years,
Blue Fleet: 11 through 12 years, Red Fleet: 13 through 15 years.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee(s), to the address in **FURTHER INFORMATION** below, to be posted or hand delivered by **midnight Wednesday, July 5, 2017**.
- 2.3 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions:
A completed entry form and fees, including the late fee, shall be submitted at registration.
- 2.4 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: The total number of competitors will be limited to 125 accepted in order of entries received. The total number of participants to be provided housing will be limited to 50. Chaperones are required for each boat housing competitors.
- 2.5 Competitors shall provide their own boat.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The required entry fee is \$50 per competitor for all classes (includes meals).
- 3.2 The late entry fee will be an additional \$20 per competitor.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration: Monday July 10 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM CDT
- 4.2 Welcome to Competitors Tuesday July 11 8:00 AM CDT
- 4.3 A maximum of 8 races are scheduled as follows:
Tuesday July 11 6 races maximum, with a lunch break
Wednesday July 12 remaining races, AM only

4.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 9:30 AM.

4.5 On Wednesday no warning signal will be made after 12:00 PM.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available online by July 8th and available at registration.

6 VENUE

The racing areas will be on the waters of Lake Michigan East of SSYC and in the Milwaukee Harbor North or South of SSYC.

7 COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

- a) Windward-Leeward of 2, 3, 4, or 5 legs, or
- b) Triangle, then 2 or 3 Windward-Leeward legs.

8 SCORING

8.1 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

8.2 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores.

9 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall display a flag provided by the Regatta committee.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- a) To each member of the crews placing first through fifth in each class in the regatta.
- b) Optimist class prizes will also be awarded in each of the Red, Blue, White, and Green fleets according to the following schedule:

1-3 boats in fleet -	1 prize
4-5 boats in fleet -	2 prizes
6 or more boats in fleet -	3 prizes

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither SSYC nor the SSYC Junior Sailing Foundation will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE

In consideration of the acceptance of my entry in the South Shore Yacht Club's Kaszube Cup Regatta (Regatta), and of the substantial volunteer effort of the volunteers by and for South Shore Yacht Club (Club) with respect to the Regatta, I the undersigned hereby:

1. Waive and release any and all claims, including claims for negligence or equivalent conduct (but not intentional conduct), which I may have against the Club, respective members, trustees, directors, officers, employees, volunteers, measurers, judges, independent contractors, sponsors, designees, successors, assigns, insurers and affiliates (hereinafter collectively "releases") resulting from my participating in the Regatta and all activities related to the Regatta. I understand that such negligence could include but is not limited to a failure to use reasonable care in deciding whether or not to start or continue a race and any other decisions arising out of race management; operating power boats, cranes, or other equipment; maintaining launch ramps, cranes, piers, docks, marks, buoys, and other property; in training or supervising employees or volunteers; in providing instructions or services; or in providing any first aid or emergency medical treatment.
2. Agree not to sue any of the releases for any damages, costs, losses, expenses, demands, claims or causes of action arising out of the Regatta.
3. Acknowledge that serious accidents may occur during the Regatta and that I may sustain death, disability, serious personal injury, and/or property damage, and acknowledge my responsibilities in participating in the Regatta, for my decisions to start or continue to race in the Regatta and to ensure that my boat, equipment and crew are seaworthy for the conditions which may be encountered during my participation.
4. Agree that this Release and Waiver of Liability is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Wisconsin and that in the event that any provision is held to be prohibited or invalid, the remainder of this Release and Waiver of Liability shall continue in full legal force and effect, and that this Release and Waiver of Liability supersedes all prior negotiations, representations or agreements between myself and any one or more of the releases.

By signing below, I acknowledge that I have read this agreement, understand its terms, have had the opportunity to review, discuss and negotiate its terms and conditions and understand that by signing, I am giving up substantial rights.
